Thank you for your ongoing work in support of Oregon and Multnomah County's child welfare system, and your willingness to participate in the upcoming facilitated planning process beginning on January 5, 2009. I am pleased by the establishment of this process, and believe that together we can safely find ways to reduce the number of children in foster care in our state. I have designated this effort – occurring in seven counties besides your own – as an Oregon Solutions project and have appointed Multnomah County Judge Nan Waller as the statewide convener.

Based on your demonstrated commitment to children and families, I am officially designating you as the convener for Multnomah County. I will look to you as the local convener to bring together other critical child welfare partners from the public, private, and civic sectors.
